Scramble Format Rules

- 1. Professionals are to play from the Cinder tees. Men play from the Championship Copper tees and women play from the Forward Lava tees.
- 2. Always use the best shot with no limit on number of drives per player.
- 3. Mark, clean, and replace within one club length of original shot, no closer to the hole. Finish every hole out; no gimmes.
- 4. The captain's score and then number of eagles and birdies will decide tiebreakers. (Eagles count as two birdies.)

Team Captains

- 1. Play summer rules unless your shot is chosen for the team which you would be allowed to lift, clean, and replace within one club length, no closer to the hole.
- 2. Always play your ball to completion.
- 3. If your shot is not chosen then you will be finishing your hole out while also playing the scramble format with your team. If the team selects a shot other than yours and you hit a better shot from your original play, it cannot be used for the scramble format.


